

PROCEDURE IN THE ACCEPTANCE OF SPECIAL MINES PERMIT APPLICATION

Filing in MGB Regional Office of the Application for Special Mines Permit (SMP) with complete mandatory* requirements



Initial evaluation by MGB RO

MGB RO notifies the applicant of the deficiencies/ returns the SMP application with all pertinent documents



Endorsement of the SMP application in the MGB Central Office (CO)



Final evaluation by MGB CO

MGB CO notifies the RO of the deficiencies/ returns the SMP application with all pertinent documents





Clearance by the DENR SECRETARY



Approval by the MGB DIRECTOR

*Mandatory Requirements:

- Application Letter. Filing Fee (PhP20.00/Ha but not less than PhP50,000.00).
- MPSA Application.
- For corporation/partnership/asso./ coop: SEC/CDA-certified Certificate Registration, Articles of Incorporation/ Partnership/ Association and By-Laws. (Note: with minimum authorized capital of PhP 100,000,000.00 and paid-up capital of PhP 6,250,000.00.
- Location Map/Sketch Plan (1:50,000 NAMRIA topographic map) prepared, sealed and signed by a deputized Geodetic Engineer.
- Proof of technical competence in the form
 - 6.1. Bio-data and track records in mining/environmental mgt.
 - 6.2. Sworn statement of the technical person(s) who will undertake the implementation of the Work Programs or employment contract.
- Proof of financial capability:
 - 7.1. For an individual:
 - 7.1.1. Statement of assets & liabilities duly sworn in accordance with existing laws
 - 7.1.2. Latest Income Tax Return 7.1.3. Credit lines/bank
 - guarantees/ deposits of at least P2.5M
 - 7.2. For corp./partnership/asso./ coop: 7.2.1. Latest audited Financial
 - Statements 7.2.2. Annual Report for the
 - preceding year
 - 7.2.3. Credit lines/bank guarantees/ deposits
